ITINERARY

Destinations Covered:-Delhi-Jammu-Katra-Srinagar-Gulmarg-Pahalgam-Srinagar-Sonmarg-Srinagar-Amritsar-Delhi **Duration:** - 12 nights/13days

Day 1: Delhi – Jammu

After arrive Delhi you will go for local sight seen like **Qutub Minar, Lotus Temple, Raj Ghat, Red Fort, Jama Masjid, India Gate and Presidential House**. And after these you will move to Jammu by Rajdhani/Duranto Express by 2 Tier AC coaches for Maa Vaishno Devi Darshan.

Day 2: Jammu -Katra

Arrive in Jammu by Train and proceed to Katra by road its 2 to 3 hours by road journey. After arrive in Katra by road and check in your hotel. After refreshment in hotel you will go for Darshan at Maa Vaishno Devi Mandir Overnight stay in hotel at Katra.

Day 3: Katra - Srinagar

Today you will proceed for Srinagar. In this route you're all over journey in shadow of Himalaya. In evening you will reach at Haven of Earth Srinagar. It's Summer Capital of Jammu & Kashmir. Overnight stay at Luxury House boat in Dal Lake in Srinagar.

Day 4: Srinagar - Gulmarg

After breakfast, drive down to Gulmarg also known as The Meadow of Flowers. The natural beauty of Gulmarg has attracted tourists since long. In fact the hill resort of Gulmarg literally means "the meadow of flowers". The snow-clad peaks and the lovely landscapes of Gulmarg have provided background for several Bollywood ventures. The slopes of Gulmarg make it Asia's only heli-skiing resort. There are immense beauty and adventure activities that make Gulmarg much more than a cool hill resort.

Enjoy the picturesque scenery of Gulmarg. Take a ride on the Gondola. View the spectacular mountains surrounding the Gulmarg valley and enjoy the crisp air of Khilanmarg. Overnight at Gulmarg.

Day 5: Gulmarg – Pahalgam

Proceed to Pahalgam (148 kms/5 hrs.). Enjoy the riverside location of Pahalgam and flowers and meadows during spring and summer. Go for walks along the Lidder River. Overnight at Pahalgam.

Days 6: Pahalgam

After breakfast the day is free to explore Lidder valley at your own or you can pick one of them - **Below given options by taking a local cab at your own cost :-**





Option1. Visit to AruValley which is a small village, 15 km upstream the Lidder River, The route is picturesque with ample campsites. This village is the starting point for treks to the Kolahoi glacier.

Option2. Visit to Chandanwari, 16 Km which is the starting point of sacred Amarnath Yatra. Chandanwari is famous for snow sledging on a snow bridge, In route you can visit Hajan, an idyllic picnic spot and Betaab valley where the famous Bollywood movie Betaab was shot.

Option3. You can enjoy leisurely walks in pine forest along River Lidder and enjoy picnic on riverside.

Option4. You can enjoy pony ride to Baisaran meadow, surrounded by thickly wooded pine forest and snow-capped mountains. This grassy glen offers a panoramic view of Pahalgam town and Lidder Valley.

Dinner & overnight stay in Hotel.

Day 7: Pahalgam – Srinagar

This morning transfer back to Srinagar. In the afternoon, enjoy a Shikara ride on the famous Dal Lake. In evening you can visit the Mughal Garden and Tulip Garden and after these you can go for souvenir shopping in the evening. Overnight at Srinagar.

Day 8: Srinagar – Sonmarg Srinagar

After an early breakfast leave for an excursion trip to Sonmarg, the Meadow of Gold. In route see the famous Sind stream. Catch the glimpse of famous Thajiwas glaciers.

Return to your hotel in Srinagar in the evening. Overnight at Srinagar.

Day 9: Srinagar

After breakfast you will move to local sight seen like that Shankaracharya Temple, Sahi Chasmaand may more which you want to cache in your album or you can full day relax in the heaven of earth.

Day 10: Srinagar - Amritsar

After breakfast you will proceed to Amritsar (460

kms and 10 to 11 Hrs. Journey). It's very scenic and greenish Journey. In evening you will arrive at Amritsar. Amritsar is a major commercial and cultural centre in the heart of Punjab. The city is the spiritual and cultural centre of the Sikh religion and is home to the Harmandir Sahib, also known as the **Golden Temple**. Respectfully marvel at the Indian and Pakistani soldiers who march-off nightly at the Wagha Border

Day 11: Amritsar

After breakfast you can visit the **Golden Temple** of Amritsar, known as swarn Mandir or swarna Mandir, located in Punjab, is the famous pilgrimage place for Sikhs in India. **and Jalianwala Bagh** is situated at a stone's throw from **The Golden Temple**. It is a witness of the disaster called Jalianwala Bagh slaughter. As the history goes, during the time of independence struggle, when **Mangal Pandey** propel the bugle for beginning the struggle for independence, **General Dyer** made a rule that no Indian will be allowed to hold assembly or processions. In evening you can visit Wagha Border. Overnight stay in hotel



Day 12: Amritsar - Delhi.

After Breakfast you will move to Delhi. Its 8 to 10 hrs. Journey and in evening you will reach in Delhi. Check in at hotel. Dinner and overnight stay at Hotel.
