Duration: 16 Nights / 17 Days

Destinations Covered:- Delhi-Mandawa-Gajner-Jaisalmer-Jodhpur-Luni-Udaipur-Deogarh-Khajrela-Pushkar-Jaipur-Fatehpur Sikri -Agra-Delhi

Day 01: Delhi

Fly from your country and arrive in Delhi, India, the erstwhile capital of 8 empires and now the capital of India with all the evidences of its glorious past intact along with the present. Upon arrival you will be escorted to the well-maintained & prestigious hotel, designated for you. check into your hotel room. Freshen up and relax at the hotel. Spend rest of the day in comforts at the hotel. Enjoy a welcome dinner organized at the hotel. Stay overnight in comforts at the hotel.

Day 02: Delhi

Have a very hearty breakfast at the hotel and then embark on a full day sightseeing tour of Old & New Delhi. During your tour to Old Delhi you will see Raj Ghat – the memorial site where Mahatma Gandhi was cremated; Jama Masjid – the largest mosque in India and the grand Red Fort – once the most opulent fort and palace of the Mughal Empire. Also enjoy the cycle rickshaw ride from Jama Masjid to bustling bazaars of Chandani Chowk.

During your sightseeing tour of New Delhi you will see the Humayun's Tomb, Qutub Minar, imposing India Gate – a war memorial, Parliament House, President House. Drive along the ceremonial avenue – Rajpath. After exploring the city of Old & New Delhi, return to the hotel. Enjoy dinner at the hotel. Stay overnight in comforts at the hotel.

Day 03: Delhi – Mandawa (275 kms; Approx 3hrs)

After very hearty breakfast at the hotel, drive to Mandawa located in the heart of Shekhawati region, Rajasthan, India. One of the small towns of the Shekhawati region of Rajasthan best set up for tourists, with plenty of forts, havelis and tourist attractions. Upon reaching Mandawa, check-in into hotel, recline a while and get ready for a trip around the town which can be very interesting and provides a varied sightseeing experience of Haveli's and Paintings. Come evening, spend the rest of the day at leisure. Overnight stay will be in a hotel.



Day 03: Mandawa-Gajner

Early morning, start exploring Gajner. The town is popular for the Gajner Fort and Gajner Wildlife Reserve. Later



drive towards Khuri which is a sand village located in Jaisalmer. The village is popular for its sand dunes. You may enjoy campfire, camel ride and folk performances here. Overnight Stay at hotel.

Day 04: Gajner-Jaisalmer

You would be on the road towards Jaisalmer after breakfast. After you check into a hotel, the rest of the day is all yours. You can either rest or do some exploration around the hotel. There are many local bazaars that would keep you busy and you can also shop for souvenirs. Have dinner and Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 05: Jaisalmer sightseeing

After breakfast, you would be exploring the city. Top attractions are Jaisalmer Fort, Patwon Ki Haveli and Singh Ki Haveli. If time permits, you would be visiting other attractions too. Later, in the evening, you would be visiting Sam sand dunes for sightseeing and camel ride. You would get back to your hotel room by late evening.



Day 06: Jaisalmer-Jodhpur

Post breakfast **drive to Jodhpur** which is known as blue city because of the blue colors that decorate many of the houses in the old city area. On arrive check in to hotel, Overnight at Jodhpur.

Day 07: Jodhpur Sightseeing

After breakfast proceed for Jodhpur Sightseeing, Visit **Mehrangarh Fort** a fort stands a hundred feet in splendour on a perpendicular cliff. Later **visit to Jaswant thada** a milky-white marble memorial to Maharaja Jaswant singh II. An **excursion of Mandore gardens** famous for its Temples, Cenotaphs and gardens. Evening free time to **explore Clock tower market**. Drop to hotel, Overnight at Jodhpur.

Day 08: Jodhpur-Luni

Luni is a small charming village that is found just a half an hour drive (35 kilometers) from Jodhpur. Luni has the most striking sight called Fort Chanwa, a testimony to the refined Indian architecture. Kaviraj Muraridanji was built by Kaviraj Muraridanji in red sandstone. It is designed with traditional paintings and the immaculate carvings that keep the spirit of the bygone era alive. The fort, now converted into a massive hotel, Maharaja Dalip Singhji and his wife Rani Madhu have kept the appeal intact. Overnight stay in the hotel.

Day 09: Luni-Udaipur

After having early breakfast, the day is reserved for exploring yet another marvel of Rajasthan, Udaipur. Popularly known as the city of lake, it is one of the most interesting places in India. Like Pushkar, Udaipur is also known for its magnificent beauty. There are ample of breathtaking views, including lakes, hills, captivating palaces, temples, and much more. As magnificent lakes and breathtaking views, surround the beauty of the place, Udaipur delivers much more than expected. Overnight Stay at Hotel.

Day 10: Udaipur Sight seeing

After spending a comfortable night in the hotel, we get ready to explore Udaipur and its vicinities. Termed as one of the most romantic cities of India, Udaipur is rich in every sense. Its City Palace gives you an opportunity to unearth beauty in its entirety. There remains much more on travelling charts such as Jagdish Temple, Saheliyon ki Bari, and Shilpgram Art Fair.

Day 11: Udaipur-Deogarh

Have a very hearty breakfast at the hotel and then drive to Deogarh en route visiting Ranakpur Jain Temples. Enjoy lavish lunch at Maharani Bagh. Upon arrival in Deogarh, stay overnight at Deogarh.

Day 12: Deogarh-Khajrela

Have a very hearty breakfast at the hotel and then drive to Khajrela. Dinner and overnight stay will be at Khajrela.

Day 13: Khajrela-Pushkar

Have a very hearty breakfast at the hotel and then drive to Pushkar – the holy city of Rajasthan, India en route visiting Dargah at Ajmer. Upon arrival at Pushkar, Visit India representative will assist you to transfer you to the well-maintained and prestigious hotel, designated for you. Freshen up and relax at the hotel. In the Evening visit the world famous temple of Lord Brahma & local markets. Dinner and overnight stay will be at the hotel.

Day 14: Pushkar-Jaipur

Day 15: Jaipur Sight seeing

After hearty breakfast at the hotel, visit the grand Amber



fort, which encloses superb palace and beautiful temple in marble dedicated to the fearsome goddess Kali. Enjoy an elephant ride up the fort's ramparts. Spend rest of the day at leisure. Sumptuous dinner and overnight stay will be at the hotel.

Day 16: Jaipur-Fatehpur Sikri-Agra

After hearty breakfast at the hotel, drive to the ['City of the Taj', Agra](#) in the state of Uttar Pradesh, India. En route, [visit the Imperial 'Ghost City' of Fatehpur Sikri](#) constructed of sandstone and built by Emperor Akbar. On arrival, Visit India representative will assist you to transfer you to the hotel.

In the afternoon take a city tour and [visit one of the 'wonders of the world', the Taj Mahal](#) with its majestic marble domes and elegant minarets. Thereafter, [visit the Agra fort](#) built by Emperor Akbar in 1565 and [the marble tomb of Itimad-Ud-Daulah](#), if time permits. Sumptuous dinner and overnight stay will be at the hotel.



Day 17: Agra- Delhi

After a hearty breakfast and a wonderful tour, proceed to Delhi.
